Administering Immunotherapy to Patient's from other Practices

We are happy to assist in providing immunotherapy for patients while in the Tallahassee area.

- All patient's must first have a new patient appointment to get established with our practice and for medical history to be reviewed (skin testing will not re-done), we will do our best to schedule this as quickly as possible please keep in mind we are often booked 6-8 weeks in advance for new patient appointments (plus we can place them on our cancellation call list).
- All patients/guardians will be required to consent to our immunotherapy policies, attached.
- Patients will need to bring with them to their new patient appointment the following:
 - serum
 - immunotherapy prescription
 - skin prick testing results (or lab result equivalent)
 - last office notes
 - immunotherapy schedule
 - immunotherapy vaccine administration log
- We will follow current allergist prescribing schedule (in accordance with AAAAI guidelines).
- We will fax current allergist an updated immunotherapy vaccine administration log with a request for new serum each time it is needed.

We hope this will allow patient care to continue to flow smoothly while the patient is away from home. Please feel free to contact our office if you have any questions.
